Lake Redman Pumping Station Tour

Join us on Monday, September 21, 2020, for the first membership meeting of the 2020-2021 program year for the Engineering Society of York and a tour of the new pumping station for the York Water Company at Lake Redman. The York Water Company recently completed this replacement project as well as the Lake Williams dam rehabilitation project. The presentation will begin with an overview of the pumping station project and focus on the mechanical systems including the pumps, motors and drives for the station. We also will discuss the permitting challenges, the treatment characteristics and operational considerations of the station. A tour of the new pumping station also will be offered.

Please be prompt as the tour is scheduled to begin at 5:00pm. Access to the pumping station is from South George Street. Please note that there is no left turn onto the access road, so attendees will need to turn around in the parking lot across from the access road. The gate will be open and visitors can drive to the pumping station and park above or at level with the station.

Due to the ongoing restrictions associated with gatherings and COVID-19, registration will be capped at a total of 25 people for this event. While this event is FREE to all members and guests, we will NOT be gathering for our social event after the meeting and dinner will NOT be offered.
